

1. Can I make more than one contact with the same station at different times throughout the event? *Yes*
2. Can I make contacts on any of the Reflector 69 Modules A, B or C. *Yes*
3. Can contacts during a scheduled controlled net count?  
*Yes, however, Refer to the Event Overview pdf file for specific details.*
4. Can contacts during an informal round-table count?  
*Yes. A round-table consists of 3 or more hams. Refer to the Event Overview pdf file on <http://ctdstar.org/> on how to handle contacts during a round-table.*
5. Can I submit a log when I reach the different tiers or do I need to wait until the end of the event?  
*You can submit as you reach each tier. You will receive a certificate for each tier after you submit via email.*
6. Where do I send my log to get a certificate?  
*Email your log of contacts as an attachment to [workedall69@gmail.com](mailto:workedall69@gmail.com)*
7. How quickly after I submit a log for a tier will I receive the certificate?  
*This will vary. Keep in mind that the event is being administered by volunteers and will do their best as they work around their work and family obligations.*
8. Can I request a printed certificate?  
*No. The event was designed to be simple while taking into account the circumstances we are all living through currently. The certificate will be a pdf file in color that can be printed by each person.*
9. I use the PNUT app. Can I participate? *Yes*
10. I use an AMBE board. Can I participate? *Yes*
11. Do I need to use the logging form while mobile? *Safety first while behind the wheel.*  
*It is up to the individual if they want to jot down contacts when they can on paper and later transfer onto the logging form.*
12. What is the deadline to get all final logs in after the event ends on Dec 31, 2021 23:59 local time?  
*The deadline date to email in your final log is January 28, 2022.*
